Expresses the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation that would achieve a 20% reduction in the per capita use of salt in water softening equipment.

Relates to bond revenue grants under the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 requires the Department of Water Resources to achieve its statewide grant allocation to address the critical water supply needs of disadvantaged communities by awarding grants for that purpose to disadvantaged communities within a hydrologic region in a total dollar amount that is equivalent to 10% of the total dollar amount of grants awarded in that region.

Provides that expenses of the conservancy may be paid from funds appropriated by the Legislature or from gifts, donations, bequests or other public and private sources.

Requires posting of the notices and reports on the public waters system's Internet Web site, if the public water system maintain an Internet Web site. Makes technical corrections to Toxics Information Clearinghouse provisions.

Provides the prohibition on a person possessing or transporting the mussels does not apply to an operator who has prepared an eradication plan.

bidder to review all relevant bid documents provided.
