RECYCLED WATER CUSTOMER DEVELOPMENT  
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT CONSTRUCTION AUTHORIZATION

SUMMARY:

District staff, in the continuing effort to expand Central Basin's customer development base, has been meeting with Pro-Growers Nursery (approximately 45 acre-feet per year) in the City of Bell Gardens for recycled water use. Pro-Growers Nursery is presently establishing its base of operation on a 12-acre lot leased from the Southern California Edison Company. At this time, staff has received approval from the Los Angeles County Department of Health Services to proceed with the retrofit service lateral construction process (capital improvement).

The following is an outline of the description of work for the capital improvement Project at the Pro-Growers Nursery site:

- Tap an existing 8-inch recycled water main on Park Lane Avenue;
- Installation of a 2-inch lateral (off a 8-inch main); and
- Installation of a 2-inch meter and vault.

The recycled water capital improvements costs are not-to-exceed \$3,000 per construction estimate (see Exhibit "A") submitted by Doty Brothers Construction Company. Mr. Mike Williams of Park Water Company, (Central Basin's field operations contractor) will oversee all onsite capital improvement procedures.

FISCAL IMPACTS:

Funds for Customer Development Projects are included in the FY 2003-04 Budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE:

No environmental documentation is required.

COMMITTEE STATUS:

This item was reviewed by the Water Resources Committee on May 11, 2004 and recommended for approval at the May 24, 2004 Board meeting.

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That the Board authorizes the General Manager to approve a "Construction Authorization" for the Capital Improvement Service Lateral Project at the Pro-Growers Nursery site in the City of Bell Gardens in the amount of \$3,000.
