CONSENT CALENDAR

RECYCLED WATER CUSTOMER DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

SUMMARY:

The following is an update on the progress of staff regarding recycled water customer development.

The following represents significant customer development projects:

- City of Downey Customer Development Research (300-400 AFY): Staff is continuing negotiations regarding a cooperative arrangement with the City of Downey's Public Works Department for serving future recycled water customers from a City pipeline infrastructure project currently in progress. At this time, staff has not received a response from City representatives.
- General Dyeing and Finishing, Incorporated (450-560 AFY – Santa Fe Springs): General Dyeing representatives have requested a three week period to allow the new Operations Manager and Mr. Parviz Safaei, President/Proprietor to review their position on the use of recycled water in the dyeing process. Upon completion of General Dyeing's review, staff will have an opportunity to meet with General Dyeing representatives to discuss the next course of action.
- Pro-Growers Nursery (40-45 AFY – Bell Gardens): Staff is pleased to announce the connection in early September 2004 of Pro-Growers Nursery in the City of Bell Gardens. Pro-Growers Nursery will occupy a 12-acre Edison easement lot adjacent to two existing recycled water customer sites, John Ford Park/soccer field.

Funds for Customer Development Projects are included in the FY 2004-05 budget.
