CONSENT CALENDAR

RECYCLED WATER CUSTOMER DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

SUMMARY:

The following is the monthly update on the progress of the District's pursuit of recycled water customers.

CBMWD Staff

The City of Vernon (City) has approved recycled water rates that will reanimate the research of prospective customers in the City and along the Southeast Water Reliability Project (SWR Project), formerly the Montebello Loop. Staff will develop a "Request for Proposals" to revise the Master Plan originally completed in 2000.

Staff is also developing a new marketing plan to reach potential recycled water customers. Staff submitted the SWR Project for Proposition 50 funding. The Project was approved but is well down the list for prioritization and grant funding remains uncertain.

Central Basin along with Tetra Tech, acting as consultants for the District, met with representatives of the City of Long Beach and the City of Signal Hill to present a Feasibility Study for Long Beach to serve recycled water to the City of Signal Hill.
