PROPOSITION 50 CUSTOMER AGENCY OUTREACH UPDATE

SUMMARY:

Since Proposition 50 came to light in the summer of 2004, staff has been actively engaged in the process, on both a District level and customer agency outreach level. As part of the District's service to its customers, staff has kept them informed on the funding available and the steps necessary to complete and submit an application for a project to the State. Staff has been in contact with many of the agencies as an information resource to answer questions and provide status information. A list of District and customer agency applications is attached as Exhibit "A".
