CONSENT CALENDAR

RECYCLED WATER CUSTOMER DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

SUMMARY:

The following is the monthly update on the progress of the District's pursuit of recycled water customers.

- The City of Vernon has notified staff that a proposal for a new power plant near the Malburg Generation Plant is proposed for 2008 and could use up to 4,000 AFY of recycled water. Staff is researching the potential to meet the demand in the requested timeframe;
- Construction has commenced on the final portion of the initial phase of Rose Hills Cemetery (900 AFY) and conversion to recycled water is expected during the third week of August; and
- The San Gabriel Valley Municipal Water District Board of Directors approved the "Memorandum of Understanding" (MOU) for the Recycled Water Master Plan revision with minor changes.
