CERTIFICATIONS OF ASSESSED VALUATIONS FOR FY2005-06 AND TABLE OF
MEMBER AGENCY PERCENTAGE PARTICIPATION, VOTING ENTITLEMENT, AND
DIRECTOR ENTITLEMENT AS OF AUGUST 16, 2005

SUMMARY:

This letter reports the certified assessed valuations as of August 16, 2005, and MWD's member agency percentage participation, vote, and director entitlement (Exhibit "A").

Central Basin's certified assessed valuation for FY 2005-06 is \$88,737,365,066, a 9.18% increase from the FY 2004-05 assessed valuation of \$81,277,969,988. Central Basin's assessed valuation accounts for 5.46% of the total within the MWD service area, a slight decrease from 5.56% in FY 2004-05. MWD calculates vote entitlement and director entitlement based on the certified assessed valuations that are reduced by Homeowner's Property Exemptions. Central Basin's vote entitlement is 8,874, and Director Entitlement remains at two. Currently, MWD has a total of 37 Directors.

Exhibit "B" displays Central Basin's historical assessed valuation since 1991.
