ULTRA-LOW FLUSH TOILET (ULFT) DISTRIBUTION UPDATE

SUMMARY:

Two successful ULFT programs were conducted to date. To avoid the holidays and rainy season, the remaining three programs will be conducted in the February through June 2006 timeframe. The following is the status of the programs:

**Division I – Director Vasquez**

**Division II – Director Apodaca**

**Division III – Director Cole**

- In partnership with California Water Service Company, a total of 836 ULFTs were distributed to the residents of East Los Angeles. Staff is currently working with its vendor to close-out the program in December and schedule the check presentation to the Door of Hope and the City Terrace Coordinating Council.

**Division IV – Director Gonzalez**

- A total of 495 ULFTs were successfully distributed to the residents of Lynwood on October 22. Of these, 458 old toilets were returned for recycling. Staff and its vendor are currently working to close-out the program in December and schedule the check presentation to the Victory Outreach and Alma Latina organizations.

**Division V – Director Hawkins**

Staff will continue working with each Director to schedule the remaining programs.
