REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) LABORATORY SERVICES AND FIELD OPERATION SERVICES

SUMMARY:

District staff recently released two "Request for Proposals" (RFP) entitled:

- "Water Quality Analytical and Courier Services"; and
- "Operations and Maintenance of the Century Recycled Water Distribution System."

Contract award consideration for both is anticipated to be presented at the Water Resources Committee in April. The synopsis of the two RFP's is as follows:

Water Quality Analytical and Courier Services

To comply with the California Department of Health Services drinking water permit for the Water Quality Protection Plan (WQPP), the District performs over 200 water quality tests per year. The testing is to be performed by laboratories certified in the State of California through the Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program. The laboratory services are currently being provided by Test America whose contract expires on June 30, 2007. The released RFP is a solicitation of services for the subsequent two year period.

Operations and Maintenance of the Century Recycled Water Distribution System

The current contract to provide operations and maintenance services on the E. Thornton Ibbeston Distribution System expires on June 30, 2007. The E. Thornton Ibbeston Distribution System is the southern half of the District's recycled water system and consists of about 50 miles of various size diameter transmission and distribution pipelines, the Hollydale Pump Station in the City of South Gate, and a metering facility in the City of Cerritos. Contract operations of the Distribution System are currently being performed by the Park Water Company. The released RFP is a solicitation of services for the subsequent fiscal year.

FISCAL IMPACTS:

Funds have been budgeted for services to be provided under both contracts.

ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE:

For WQPP, water quality sampling and analysis is a required component of operating a domestic water supply system.
