**FORMER CENTRAL BASIN GENERAL MANAGER JOHN G. JOHAM, JR.
PASSES AWAY JANUARY 4, 2008**

Commerce, CA- Former Central Basin Municipal Water District General Manager John G. Joham, Jr. passed away Friday, January 4, 2008 in Westminster, CA.

Born in Los Angeles, Mr. Joham was actively employed in the Southern California water industry for more than thirty years. Beginning in 1974, he concurrently served as the General Manager of Central Basin Municipal Water District; Central & West Basin Water Replenishment District; and West Basin Municipal Water District. Before his retirement in 1989, the Central Basin Board of Directors presented Mr. Joham with a resolution commending his many years of outstanding service and dedication.

During his tenure, Mr. Joham also served as the Vice Chairman of the Southern California Water Conference; a Trustee of the Southern California Water Committee; a Director for the Association of California Water Agencies (ACWA); a Vice President of the Southern California Water Conference; and as a member of the ACWA Groundwater Committee.

Additionally, Mr. Joham was a valued and active member of the American Water Works Association; the National Water Well Association; the Southern California Waste Forum; and the Water Pollution Control Federation.
